Langham Place Opens MTR Mongkok Station Subway Link

Officiating at the opening ceremony of the new subway, Mr. Tong Chun-wan, Managing Director of Great Eagle Development and Project Management Ltd., said, "The opening of the new MTR entrance is a key milestone in the comprehensive traffic enhancement scheme for the area surrounding Langham Place. Passengers, shoppers, office workers and hotel guests are now provided with a more convenient and comfortable access to Langham Place, regardless of weather conditions. We expect to see a major increase in the flow of shoppers to the Mall as a result."

The interior finishing of the MTR-Langham Place subway has been designed to complement the iconic architecture of Langham Place's gigantic rock façade with all walls and floors outfitted in Golden Moon stone - golden yellow granite specially sourced from Brazil.

Construction of The MTR-Langham Place subway commenced in 2003. It is a joint effort of the MTR Corporation, the Urban Renewal Authority and the Great Eagle Group.
